Fire Safety

Classroom instruction is given using the Learn Not to Burn Curriculum and the Hazard House. Children will also have a chance to practice their "Get Out and Stay Out" skills in the Children's Fire Safety Trailer.

First Aid

A hands-on approach to life saving skills that will arm students with the confidence to provide basic first aid. Learn when you should call 911 and what you need to know when you do.



- Registration deadline is April 15, 2011 for the spring session.
- Bookings are available on a first come, first served basis. School programs will run Tuesday and Thursday mornings, from May 3 - June 23, 2011 and September 13 - October 27, 2011.
- One chaperone for every eight children is required. Due to Safety City liability only registered students may attend the program.
- Programs will run rain or shine.
- Maximum group of students is 50 per program day.
- The program day will incorporate two 45 minutes lessons.
- Lessons taught by your local RCMP, Enforcement Services, Fire Department, EMS, Alberta Health Services, St John Ambulance, AMA School Safety Patrol and other qualified instructors.
