



Planning a Trip to Safety City

Schools serving the residents of the City of Grande Prairie can choose from the following programs:

- **Street Smarts with Mud, Mammals & Machines**, Tuesday mornings, 9:30am – 11:30am.
- **Fire Safety and Emergency Safety** on Tuesday afternoons, 12:30pm – 2:30pm
- **Barnyards and Boots** on Wednesdays – 9:30am – 11:30am **or** 12:30pm – 2:30pm

Schools serving residents of the County of Grande Prairie #1 or MD of Greenview can choose from the following programs:

- **Street Smarts with Barnyards and Boots**, Thursday mornings – 9:30am – 11:30am
- **Fire Safety and Emergency Safety**, Thursday afternoons – 12:15pm – 2:15pm
- **Barnyards and Boots**, Wednesdays, 9:30am – 11:30am **or** 12:30pm – 2:30pm

Groups will be divided into two; each group will do a 50-minute session then switch. Feel free to arrive with nametags on your students, as they are a big help to instructors.

Fees: \$2.00 per child. We can accept cash or cheques from schools. If paying by cheque, please have checks made out to Grande Prairie and Area Safe Communities. All proceeds are used to support and develop Safety City programming.

Food: We do not supply food or beverages. A snack may be enjoyed at our facility, if time permits. The main building does have a water fountain.

Dress Accordingly: Educational components are held indoors, but training and hands on exercises will have an outdoor component. Please ensure children have appropriate clothing for the weather conditions. It is preferred that the children wear closed toed shoes.

Cancellation Policy: Programs will run rain or shine. Some program elements may be modified to accommodate weather related issues. (Example – our jeeps cannot be out in the rain) As classes will often still be walking or standing outside regardless of weather conditions, we do ask that children are dressed appropriately for the weather and for warmth. In the unlikely event that a cancellation is necessary due to circumstances beyond our control, we will make every effort to give as much notice to teachers as is possible.

Chaperone Involvement: Teachers must have at least **three** adult chaperones, per class. Please ensure that your chaperones **DO NOT** bring younger/older children with them, which are not part of the registered class. Chaperones will be asked to assist in actively monitoring, supervising, and reinforcing lessons as required, during all Safety City activities. When students are walking on the streets of Safety City or riding in motorized vehicles, they will require close supervision.



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Student Conduct: Your visit is expected to be a fun learning experience. Students are required to follow appropriate rules of conduct as expected at school. Students are expected to follow safe practices during all activities. Please ask students to leave all electronic devices, including cell phones at school.

Bus Information: Our parking lot can only be accessed by travelling South on 92nd Street and turning right into the parking lot. There is also a new bus pull out for dropping off and picking up students, southbound on 92 Street, just before reaching our building.
